## Human Resource Development

The beneficiaries of the NCCS academic programmes during the year 2019-20 are as follows: Twenty-six Research Fellows joined NCCS, and twenty-six research scholars registered for a Ph.D. with the University during this year, taking the total number of registered Ph.D. students to a hundred and seven, as on 31st March, 2020. Twenty-one students submitted their thesis to the University for Evaluation, and twenty-two students were awarded with a Ph.D. degree during the said year.

NCCS also conducts training programmes for students every year, as given below:

a) Project training is imparted either over 6-months' twice a year (during January-June and July December), or over one year.

b) Summer training is conducted for 2 months during May-June. The summer trainees are selected from among the Indian Academy of Sciences Summer Research Fellows of the respective year.

The number of students who received training under these programmes during 2019-20 is as follows: Project Trainees: 38 Summer Trainees: 26
